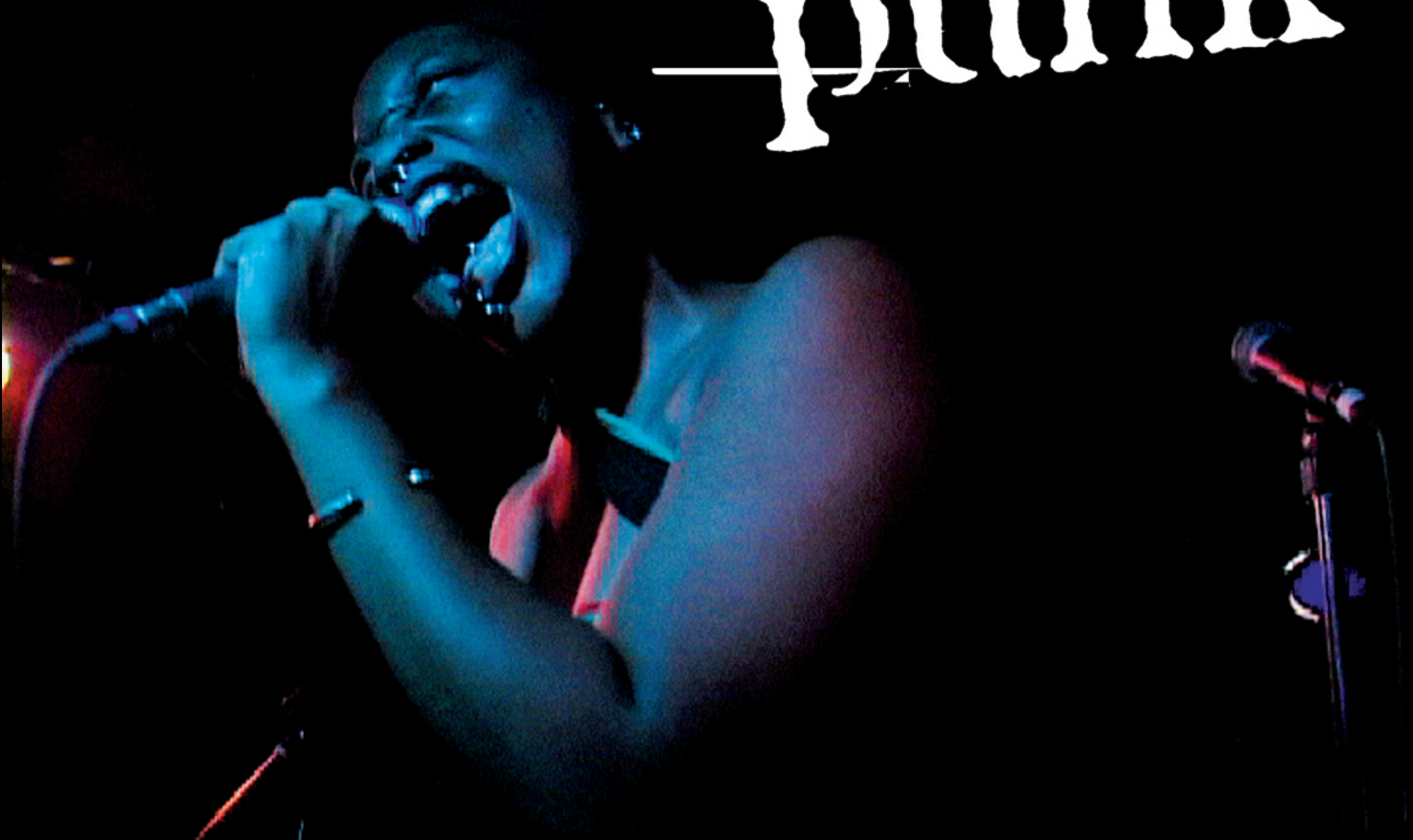


afro-punk
