She serves as department chair and director of the Binational/Cross-Cultural Health Enhancement Center. Her research focuses on two areas: fluorides and cross-cultural health. Her talk will focus on her community-based research in the area of cross-cultural and binational (US and Mexico) health designed to address and identify disparities in dental caries and dental fluorosis in Latino/Hispanic patients. She has also helped develop extensive service-learning opportunities in Mexico and throughout Latin America for IU School of Dentistry students. Faculty, staff, and students interested in public health, community-based research, and service learning will find her work particularly relevant.
